



Camp Crop Away “Hotel Version”

Great news! Since we couldn't get Camp Ademac for a fall crop, I have booked us into a hotel.

We will be cropping the weekend away in luxury at the newly renovated Travelodge in Whitby from 6:00 pm on Friday November 5th to 3:00 pm on Sunday November 7th.

The cost is \$150 plus the cost of your room and the cost of 2 lunches & 1 dinner. But I was able to get a group booking at a cost of 100 per night per room for up to 4 people. So you can enjoy a hotel suite for \$50 each, for the weekend. This brings the total to \$200 which you would have been paying at Camp Ademac. The only additional cost will be lunches and dinner. We can order in, you can take a break and go out or you can even bring your food with you. I will gladly do a food run for those who want to keep on scrapping. A deluxe hot and cold continental breakfast is included each morning. (Believe me, this is more than a typical “continental” of muffins and danishes!) We will have an eating area separate from the crop room available to us.
